	<p>"The 2011 Assyrtiko Idisma Drios was oak aged for 5 months in used oak (30% 1 year old barrels, 40% 2 years old, 30% 3 years old). The oak is a mixture of 85% French and 15% American. It comes in at 13.5% alcohol. If I liked last year's version, and this year's similarly constructed sibling (the Chardonnay), this is likely a small step ahead of both. Beautifully constructed, with a slighter fuller body than the Chard and with considerable persistence on the finish, the oak is there, but reasonably well integrated. As with the Chardonnay sibling, the acidity zaps through the oak easily and gives this a very different demeanor. This even turns a little steely. Even if (like me) you tend to prefer your Assyrtiko without oak, this is hard to argue against. It is both interesting and charming. It should hold a few years, but it is lovely now and will drink great this summer, like its Chardonnay sibling." - Reviewed by: The Wine Advocate - 89pts</p>

	<p>"The 2012 Pithos Bianco is a pure expression of Grecanico macerated on its skins for seven months in clay amphorae that are buried underground. It pours into the glass revealing a light orange color that is laced with brilliant highlights of shiny gold and amber. The bouquet is immediately enticing with delicate nuances of dried peach, orange peel, creme caramel, candied fruit and fresh almond paste. You can't beat the complexity of Pithos Bianco. As it opens aromatically, it begins to show seductive slivers of dried mint leaf, cardamom, wet terracotta and crushed oyster shell or marine salt. The 2012 vintage is epic in its opulence and intensity – one of the best I've tasted so far. To be expected from a white wine that sees extended skin contact, the wine shows a tannic bite and firm supporting structure. The mouthfeel is dry to the point of feeling dusty, with the alcohol registering at a low 10.5% (although it feels warmer). Even if you are not a fan of the "orange" school of winemaking, there is no denying this wine's profound appeal. I look forward to checking in on its evolution ten years from now. This is a masterpiece."</p>

	<p>"This single-vineyard Grechetto from "Poggio della Costa" is in the commune of Civitella d'Agliano, which covers a surface of 7 hectares, facing east at an altitude of 140 meters. The wine undergoes slow and controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks and spends time on its lees for added complexity. It is a wine with full and exotic fruit aromas. On the palate a the bright citrus fruit and acidity carry into a creamy finish." - Reviewed by: Producer</p>
